Each year, various organizations put together programs for Thanksgiving and Christmas to help feed, clothe and take care of those less fortunate. What happens the other days of the year? The Sandwich Project was established with the other days in mind. The starting goal was to help feed 150 homeless people in Minneapolis as many times a year as possible, with the ultimate goal of doing it every day of the year. Today, we are helping to feed about 4,500 people per week through various shelters and food shelves.
